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Dear Clearway Mobility team,

Analyzing bike-share data for municipal transit planners isn't just a domain I'm interested in — it's the exact problem space I've spent the past year working in for the Berlin Senate Department for Transport.

For my thesis project, I analyzed 2.3 million bike-share trip records using SQL and pandas to quantify weather impacts on ridership. Beyond the statistical analysis, I built a Python pipeline that cut the department's monthly report preparation from three days to four hours, and presented the results to a non-technical city planning panel that adopted two of my recommendations into a pilot program.

Complementing my urban transport focus, my business intelligence work at Marktplatz24 grounded me in data quality monitoring. While maintaining Metabase dashboards, I caught a recurring data-quality bug that had been inflating return-rate metrics by 12%. I bring that same scrutiny to large-scale trip datasets, ensuring municipal partners base infrastructure decisions on vetted, reliable numbers.

At Clearway Mobility, my immediate focus would be helping automate recurring reporting workflows and building Metabase dashboards that translate complex trip data into clear, actionable direction for city planners across Europe.
